

# Alternative Math Options

## 8th Grade Math/Math Essentials

**Special Education Terms**  
**RSP**- a program to help children who qualify for special education services.  
**IEP**- defines the individualized objectives of a child who has been found with a disability

Moderate/Severe students will be placed in functional math focusing on IEP documentation

### Integrated Mathematics I CSU/UC a-g college prep course

- Higher functioning Resource Specialist Program (RSP) students may be placed in Integrated Mathematics I based on Individualized Education Program (IEP) documentation

### Integrated Math I (A)

- RSP and higher functioning Mild/Moderate students may be placed in Integrated Math I (A) based on IEP documentation
- Students completing the Math I (A) Math I (B) sequence will complete the 1 year algebra requirement

### Math Essentials 1

- Mild/Moderate and higher functioning Moderate/Severe students may be placed in Math Essentials I based on IEP documentation
- Students will be placed in Math 1 (A) Math 1 (B) sequence upon completion of Math Essentials 1 and/or Math Essentials 2 to complete the 1 year algebra requirement

- RSP Students based on IEP documentation
- Higher functioning Mild/Moderate students based on IEP documentation

### Integrated Math I (B)

- RSP and higher functioning Mild/Moderate students based on IEP documentation

### Math Essentials II

- Mild/Moderate and higher functioning Moderate/Severe students based on IEP documentation

### Integrated Mathematics III CSU/UC a-g college prep course

- RSP students based on IEP documentation
- Higher functioning Mild/Moderate students based on IEP documentation

### Integrated Math II (A)

- RSP and higher functioning Mild/Moderate students based on IEP documentation

### Integrated Math I (A)

- Mild/Moderate students and higher functioning Moderate/Severe students based on IEP documentation

### Integrated Math II (B)

- RSP and higher functioning Mild/Moderate students based on IEP documentation

- Mild/Moderate students and higher functioning Moderate/Severe students based on IEP documentation
